Course Description: Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD) is a complex, lifelong and often misunderstood diagnosis. This session will explore difficulties that are commonly experienced by people with FASD and provide tools and strategies that can be used to offset some of those challenges and improve quality of life. Particular attention will be paid to the experiences of people with FASD as well as those who support them.

Identify ways to better support the challenges associated with FASD on a day-to-day basis. Best practices, anecdotal evidence and practical strategies and tools will be discussed.
